

Little Miss and Mister Hardin County Fair Pageant Rules and Regulations

1. Contestant **MUST** be a **FULL TIME** resident of Hardin County. If in school must be a **FULL TIME** student in the Hardin Co or E'town City Schools and may be home schooled.
2. Contestant must have reached their 5th birthday by midnight of June 30th, and cannot have reached their 8th birthday by midnight of June 30th, of the year the pageant is held.
3. Contestant will show in short or street length dresses for girls and pants and shirt for boys. **NO** long dresses, pageant dresses, tuxedos or parts of tuxedos will be allowed.
4. Entry forms must be submitted by date of final rehearsal. Please give as much information on entry form as possible. The MC will be announcing this information while contestants are on stage.
5. Contestants **MUST** compete as a couple.
6. **ENTRY FEE FOR THE CONTEST SHALL BE \$25.00 per child. Make checks payable to LITTLE MISS & MISTER HARDIN COUNTY PAGEANT.**
7. The Pageant will be held at the Hardin County Fair Grounds. Parents and/or legal guardians are responsible to and from rehearsals and pageant.
8. The winners of this pageant will proceed on to the State competition held in Louisville during the state fair. Therefore we will also need a copy of your birth certificate to keep on file.
9. Winners will receive \$50.00 each to use toward state pageant expenses. This money will be given to the winners at state pageant time.
10. The Hardin County Fair Board, it's affiliates or its volunteers are to not be held responsible for Accidents, thefts or damages.
11. The Hardin County Fair Board, its affiliates or its volunteers are not to be held responsible in any way for any disqualifications of winners. Grounds for disqualification can be **BUT** not limited to: untrue statements made on registration form, unruly behavior, misconduct, obscene, foul language and any other reasons the pageant committee may deem as necessary.
13. **ABSOLUTELY NO** cameras or cell phones allowed behind the stage. If seen will be taken away til after the pageant.
14. Paperwork must be given to the coordinator of the pageant **NO LATER** than 30 days after Pageant or alternate will be crowned and you must forfeit all awards and monies.
